





Scholarship Program for Kuwaitis pursuing a Master's Degree

Application and enrollment conditions

In the framework of the social responsibility, the Central Bank of Kuwait and Kuwaiti banks strive to continue to encourage educational attainment, by preparing and developing qualified and professional national cadres and competencies capable of contributing to the development process of the State of Kuwait.

The Central Bank of Kuwait and Kuwaiti banks are annually providing scholarships for Kuwaiti graduates in order to obtain Master's degree from the top universities in the world according to international classifications in this field, in majors of: cyber security, financial technology, digital technology, risk management.

It is required for the applicants, in order to be accepted in the scholarship, to comply with the following conditions:

- 1. Must be Kuwaiti national.
- 2. Must not be older than 35 years of age.
- 3. Must be an employee in one of the Kuwaiti banks.
- 4. Must not be a holder of a master's degree or any equivalent degree.
- 5. Must not have been previously awarded a Master's degree scholarship by any other authority within the State of Kuwait and approval of the scholarship award shall be in the scholarship's designated academic year.
- 6. Must have obtained a university degree from a university recognized by the Ministry of Higher Education in the State of Kuwait, with a grade of not less than 3 points (four-point system) at least, or its equivalent.
- 7. Must obtain an unconditional acceptance from an accredited university, according to the latest list issued by the committee for accredited universities.
- 8. The required Master's degree for the applicant must be "Cyber Security, Financial Technology, Digital Technology, Risk Management".

Required Documents for Application:

- 1. To Whom It May Concern Certificate and transcript of academic qualifications.
- 2. Unconditional acceptance to study at Master's level from an international university accredited by the Scholarship Program for Kuwaitis Pursuing a Master's Degree Committee to obtain a Master's degree, and from the Ministry of Higher Education in the state of Kuwait.
- 3. Completed candidacy application form.
- 4. The applicant's CV.
- 5. A copy of: the civil ID, the nationality certificate, the passport, the birth certificate.
- 6. 2 photos, size 4x3 cm.

The Institute of Banking Studies shall announce the scholarships, receive and sort applicant's applications according to the terms and requirements of the regulation of the Scholarship Program for Kuwaitis Pursuing a Master's Degree, in addition to following up the applicants' affairs, application of the rules and systems of the regulation.
